Nationwide, seven people die each day in home fires, and a fire-related injury is reported every 40 minutes. The goal of the Red Cross Home Fire Preparedness Campaign is to reduce the number of deaths and injuries caused by home fires by 25 percent over a five-year period.

One cornerstone of the campaign is going door to door where it counts the most. The Red Cross is joining with community groups and fire departments across the U.S. – including Sunrise Fire-Rescue – to install smoke alarms and deliver fire prevention information.

The Red Cross and its partners will install a limited number of free smoke alarms for those who cannot afford to purchase smoke alarms or for those who are physically unable to install a smoke alarm.
